



1. Organizer

1.1. The organizer of the international event BILLA ŽAMPA CUP SKI RACE for children and youth is Žampa Ski Club, located at Starý Smokovec 62, 062 01 Vysoké Tatry, Slovakia.

2. Venue

2.1. The ŽC - CZECH REPUBLIC event will take place on the Javor 3 slope in the Pec pod Sněžkou resort.

2.2. The ŽC - POLAND event will take place on the 2c slope in the Białka Tatrzańska resort.

2.3. The ŽC - SLOVAKIA event will take place on the Interski slope in the Štrbské Pleso resort.

3. Description of the Event (Races)

3.1. ŽC - Czech Republic: Kombi race track with elements of slalom, giant slalom, and Super-G. The track may include features such as waves, and terrain variations.

3.2. ŽC - Poland: The competition is held in the downhill discipline. Different courses may be set for various categories.

3.3. ŽC - Slovakia: The competition is held in parallel slalom, preceded by a single-run qualification for all categories.

4. Categories

The ŽC races are exclusively designated for the following boys and girls categories:

- A) U10 (birth years 2015, 2016, 2017)
- B) U12 (birth years 2013, 2014)
- C) U14 (birth years 2011, 2012)
- D) U16 (birth years 2009, 2010)
- E) Team point competition – categories U10, U12, U14, U16

4.2. Hobby Subcategory

- A. A hobby athlete is a person who has never been a member of any ski club and has not participated in active ski training.
- B. Athletes, parents, and coaches must confirm that the athlete meets the conditions for the hobby category. Confirmation is done during registration by checking the relevant box in the online registration system..
- C. In the spirit of fair play, all participants, parents, and coaches are encouraged to allow true amateurs to compete for prizes without unfair competition from experienced skiers..
- D. The organizer cannot independently verify whether an athlete meets the conditions of the hobby category and relies on the honest behavior of participants and their legal guardians.
- E. If it is proven that an athlete in the hobby category does not meet the specified conditions, the organizer reserves the right to disqualify them.
- F. The prize giving of hobby athletes (only at the Žampa Cup - SLOVAKIA) will take place separately within the main category, and prizes will be awarded specifically for this subcategory.

5. Registration

5.1. Athletes register exclusively through the online registration system available on the website (www.zampacup.com).



5.2. Registrations via email, phone, or other methods are not accepted.

5.3. Online registration for the Žampa Cup races closes on the following dates:

- A) CZE - 15. 1. 2025, 20:00
- B) POL - 19. 2. 2025, 20:00
- C) SVK - 26. 3. 2025, 20:00

5.3.1. The organizer reserves the right to close registration earlier if there is a high number of entries.

5.4. All participants, coaches, and parents must provide truthful information (name, surname, birth year, club affiliation, nationality, contact details) during registration.

5.5. The organizer reserves the right to disqualify an athlete or team that provides false or incomplete information.

5.6. By registering for the races, the participant (coach or parent) grants the organizer permission to publicly display the provided personal data on result lists, photos, or videos obtained during the event, as well as to publish photos or videos on the official event page and in public media to inform the general public about the event.

5.7. The organizer has the right to collect, analyze, and store participants' personal data, as well as information, photos, and video materials.

5.8. The Žampa Cup event is not affiliated with any national association and is a public competition intended for recreational skiers as well as children from ski clubs.

5.9. The Žampa Cup organizer does not verify actual membership in clubs and national associations.

6. Skipass - Lift Tickets

6.1. Participants in the event are entitled to a voucher for purchasing a skipass at a reduced price. The voucher will be provided during registration. The entitlement to the voucher may vary by location.

- A) CZE - voucher for 1 day
- B) POL - no voucher entitlement
- C) SVK - voucher for 2 days

7. Start Order and Start Numbers

7.1. The categories will start in the following order:

- A) U10 Girls
- B) U10 Boys
- C) U12 Girls
- D) U12 Boys
- E) U14 Girls
- F) U14 Boys
- G) U16 Girls
- H) U16 Boys



7.2. Start numbers will be given to coaches or parents at the race office on the evening before the race during registration.

7.3. Athletes are required to return their start numbers to a designated location, after which the number will be entered into a raffle.

8. Race Rules - ŽAMPA CUP - CZECH REPUBLIC

8.1. The race consists of a single timed run.

8.2. The start order for each category will be randomly drawn using a computer system.

8.3. Correct course navigation: both ski tips and feet must pass through the gate in the correct turning direction.

8.4. The organizer may require a rerun of the race run.

9. Race Rules - ŽAMPA CUP - POLAND

9.1. The race follows the rules of the downhill discipline.

9.2. The race consists of a single timed run.

9.3. The start order for each category will be randomly drawn using a computer system.

9.4. Correct course navigation: both ski tips and feet must pass through the gate in the correct turning direction.

9.5. The organizer may require a rerun of the race run.

10. Qualification and Race Rules - ŽAMPA CUP - SLOVAKIA

10.1. Qualification – the qualification course will be set up next to the main race course (unless the organizer decides otherwise).

10.2. Athletes in the qualification round start according to the start number assigned to them for qualification.

10.3. The start order in the qualification round for each category will be randomly drawn using a computer system.

10.4. The start order in the main race for each category will be determined based on the qualification results according to rule (10.7.).

10.5. In the case of a large number of registered athletes, the organizer may decide on a qualification run, from which only the top 8, 16, or 32 athletes will advance to the main race or parallel race.

10.6. The top 8, 16, or 32 athletes (as decided by the organizer) from each category will advance to the main race, which will take place on Sunday and will be broadcast live on JOJ ŠPORT television.

10.7. Main race – the start order in the main race for each category is assigned based on the qualification ranking as follows:



“(example – the fastest athlete from the qualification will compete against the 16th fastest athlete from the qualification)”

In the case of 16 athletes advancing:

Duel 1: 1-16
Duel 2: 8-9
Duel 3: 5-12
Duel 4: 4-13
Duel 5: 3-14
Duel 6: 6-11
Duel 7: 7-10
Duel 8: 2-15

In the case of 8 athletes advancing:

Duel 1: 1-8
Duel 2: 5-4
Duel 3: 3-6
Duel 4: 7-2

10.8. The course, or the course color, will be determined by the system. The blue course will be set on the skiers right. The race consists of a single run. The athlete who wins their run (duel) advances further in the competition.

10.8.1. If both athletes fall during a run (duel), the athlete who fell closer to the finish line will advance.

10.8.2. If an athlete falls during a run (duel) and prevents their opponent from passing through their course, the athlete who was impeded in the run or knocked to the ground will advance.

10.8.3. If both athletes fall simultaneously during a run (duel), the run will be repeated.

10.8.4. In the case of a tie for 16th place in the qualification, the athlete with the higher start number will advance.

10.8.5. In the case of a tie in the main competition, the athlete will advance:

A) with the better time in the qualification
B) if both athletes had the same time in the qualification, the athlete with the higher start number from the qualification will advance.

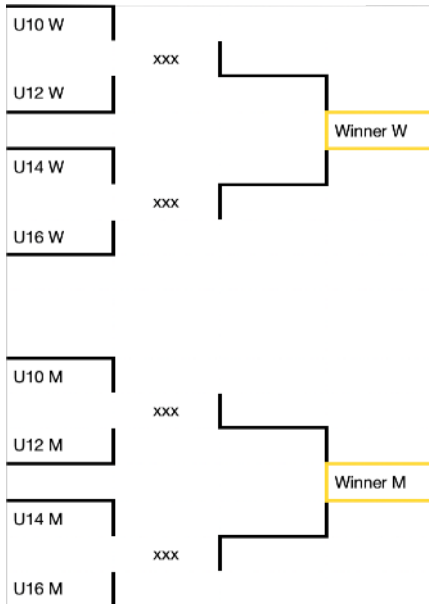
10.8.6. In the case of a tie in the small or big final, the athlete will win:

A) with the better time in the qualification
B) if both athletes had the same time in the qualification, the athlete with the higher start number from the qualification will advance.

10.8.7. The organizer may require a rerun of the race.

11. Žampa Cup - Super Final - SLOVAKIA

11.1. The winner of each category will advance to the Super Final based on the image below:



11.2. In the case of a tie in the Super Final, the younger athlete of the pair will advance.

12. Team Point Competition (powered by LISKI) brought to you by LISKI

12.1. The overall ranking of the team point competition will be determined based on the points earned from all three Žampa Cup events in the 2024/2025 season.

12.1.1. Scoring events:

- A) Žampa Cup - Pec pod Sněžkou
- B) Žampa Cup - Białka Tatrzańska
- C) Žampa Cup - Štrbské Pleso (qualification)

12.1.2. The top 5 teams in the LISKI point competition will receive prizes from the event partners: LISKI, Ski World Cup Gran Risa - Alta Badia, Skids – International Ski Race, and Oakley.

12.2. Each athlete finishing in the top 30 will earn points for their club (see image below).

12.3. Coaches are requested to emphasize the correct completion of the application and the assignment of the athlete to the correct club. Protests and errors identified after registration or during the evaluation of results will not be accepted.

12.4. The prize giving of the team point competition will take place on Sunday along with the evaluation of the main races at Štrbské Pleso.

13. Prize Giving

13.1. In the main races (CZE, POL, SVK), the top 3 athletes will be awarded.

- A) U8 (birth years 2017) – top 3 athletes
- B) U10 (birth years 2015 – 2016) – top 3 athletes
- C) U12 (birth years 2013 – 2014) – top 3 athletes
- D) U14 (birth years 2011 – 2012) – top 3 athletes
- E) U16 (birth years 2009 – 2010) – top 3 athletes



(In each category, the top 3 hobby athletes will be awarded separately - ONLY for ŽC - SLOVAKIA.)

13.2. Additional Prize Giving for ŽC - SLOVAKIA

13.2.1. The top 5 teams in the LISKI point competition will receive prizes from the event partners: LISKI, Ski World Cup Gran Risa - Alta Badia, Skids – International Ski Race, and Oakley.

13.2.2. SANACLIS SKILLS RUN – fastest girl and fastest boy.

13.2.3. Žampa Cup – Super Final (Štrbské Pleso)

A) Overall winner among girls

B) Overall winner among boys

14. Responsibility

14.1. Races for children and youth may lead to injuries. The organizers assume no responsibility for accidents that occur before, during, or after the races. Participation is solely at the risk of the athletes, their parents, and/or responsible guardians.

14.2. The person filling out the registration form voluntarily agrees to the event rules by checking the "RULES" box.

14.3. The use of a helmet designed for alpine skiing during the races is mandatory for all participants!

14.4. Each participant is individually responsible for securing accident insurance, health insurance, medical expense insurance, or other types of insurance at their discretion.

15. Changes in the Program

15.1. The organizer reserves the right to change the program, race rules, and venue if necessary.

15.2. The organizer reserves the right to make changes and additions to these rules.

15.3. If the organizer is forced to cancel the event due to force majeure, weather, war, terrorism, or other threats, participants will not be entitled to reimbursement of expenses related to the races (e.g., transportation, accommodation, skipass, etc.).

16. Protesty

16.1. There are no protests at the Žampa Cup. These races are primarily about fun and enjoying a great day on the snow.
